Summer Bridge will run through July 22nd. 15 KK students were invited. 45 1st graders were invited and 30 2nd graders were invited. Transportation will be provided door to door. A list of students and their addresses have been sent to the BOE transportation department. Typically, students that were invited are scoring closer to the average range (30th-40th percentile). PEC and ELL students were invited as well that fell into that criteria.
