VI. SGT Chair Report

i. New Business

a. Cares Act Money

Mrs. Edge did share with the SGT that there will be more federal money coming to add Jasper County Schools with learning loss and safety. This money will not come till July. Mr. Garland has asked principals to begin drafting ideas to help with learning loss for the summer and once the school year begins. Mrs. Edge did ask the SGT to brainstorm possible ideas to help in these areas and to email her any ideas as well. Mrs. Edge shared a few of hers including our summer school in July, after school tutoring starting in FY 22, playground equipment, completing renovations at JCPS, more paraprofessionals in the classroom, etc.

b. Summer School- July

Mrs. Edge did explain that summer school will begin July 5th and run through the 22nd of July. 7:30 till 1:00 PM daily. We will not have summer school on Fridays. I have teachers and paras to work with our students during that month. We reviewed data to invite our students that were scoring below the 50th percentile for some extra remediation. We have sent home letters and will send a 2nd round of letters soon. We will call parents for those that have not returned their forms. Breakfast and lunch will be provided. Transportation will also be provided.

c. SGT Nominations- SGT members coming off of SGT

We will want to hold SGT elections during award days in late May. Mr. Favors is ending his term but would like to stay on as community member. Ross Hays will also come off. Kasey Jordan will also roll off as a member. Olivia Esparza will also roll off. We will have at least 3 openings. Ross Hays, Kasey Jordan and Olivia Esparza. Mrs. Edge will get a letter out asap about the 3 openings on Facebook, newspaper, and something sent home with the students. Interested parents or community members can email pedge@jasper.k12.ga.us if they are interested in being nominated for SGT for FY 22 and Fy 23. Parents or community members will email Mrs. Edge if they would like to be placed into nomination by May 7th at 4 Pm. The person will need to write a short biography about themselves and why they want to be on SGT. Mrs. Edge will compile that information and send home to parents during the week of May 10th. Parents will vote in person on the date of their child's award program in the media center.

d. Awards Day

Awards day will take place for KK on May 21st. 2 classes at a time. 1st grade will have their awards on May 24th. 2nd grade will have their awards on May 28th. All students should attend till the last day of school on May 28th. We will not limit guests to those awards.
